TWA and STEL Alarm Viewer for Micro IV Gas Detector

- 1. Download the zip file and extract it to a known location on your hard drive by clicking on the file name and saving it. Make a note of the location where it is saved.
- Next, extract all files from the zip file to an empty folder on your computer hard drive, including any sub-folders. This will give
 you the software necessary to view the TWA and STEL information using your internet browser.
 Note: It works best with Firefox and Chrome internet browsers.

To Use the Data Logger:

- 1. Using the DI220 docking station, download the data from your Micro IV. **Note**: *The datalogging Interval must be set to 1 minute*.
- 2. Save the file by selecting "Save As", and save the file as "type" .txt, not as the .csv default setting.
- 3. Now open the folder containing the software for the website that you saved, and double click on "DDS_v4419". Your browser should open with the GfG logo.
- 4. Click on the "browse" button, and select the data file you downloaded (it must be a .txt file).
- 5. Use the navigation buttons on the top and bottom of the viewer to view alarm levels, gas values, sensor graphs, etc...
